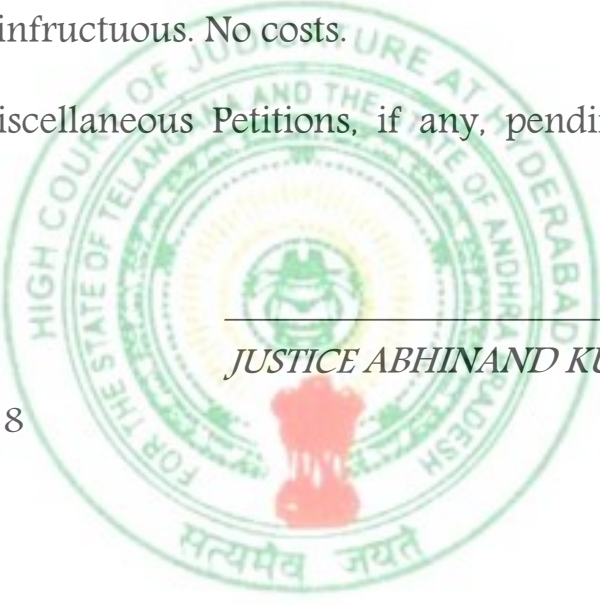
WRIT PETITION No.22095 of 2001
