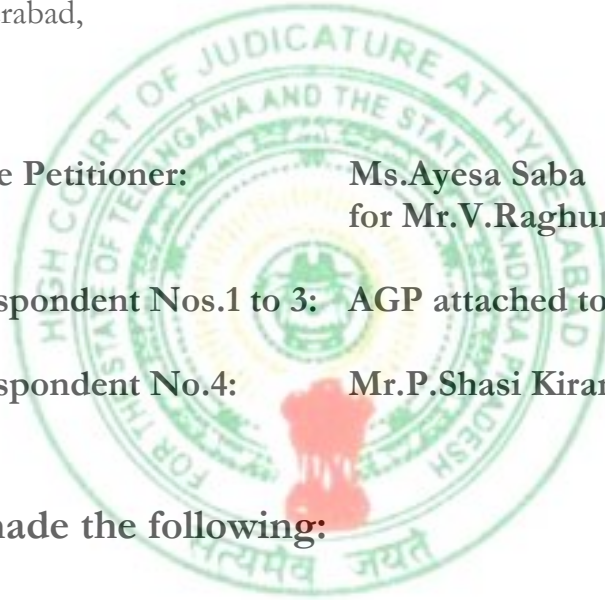

The Court made the following:



Order: (Per the Hon'ble Sri Justice C.V.Nagarjuna Reddy)

This Writ Petition is filed for a Habeas Corpus for production of the petitioner's daughter- Kotla Kavitha (for short 'the alleged *detenue*') before this Court and setting her free.

In pursuance of the direction issued by this Court on 12.06.2018, respondent No.5- Sub-Inspector of Police, Vangoor Police Station, Nagar Kurnool District, has produced before this Court, the alleged *detenue* and respondent No.4, whom she is stated to have married.

The petitioner and her husband are also personally present. In their presence, the alleged *detenue* informed that she has voluntarily married respondent No.4 and that she is living happily with him. When the petitioner and her husband requested the alleged *detenue* to join them for spending a few days with them, the alleged *detenue* has bluntly declined their request and requested the Court to allow her to live with respondent No.4.

In the light of the view expressed by the alleged *detenue*, who is, admittedly, a major, the prayer in this Writ Petition cannot be granted.

The Writ Petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
