

**THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE M.S.RAMACHANDRA RAO**

**WRIT PETITION No.21701 OF 2018**

**ORDER:**

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Government Pleader for Finance Planning for 1<sup>st</sup> respondent, Sri V.Narasimha Goud, for 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent and Sri G.Narendar Reddy, for respondents 3 and 4.

2. Petitioner's grievance is that petitioner has made a building permission application to the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent on 25.05.2017 online and no action has been taken by 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent in that regard.

3. Sri V.Narasimha Goud, learned standing counsel for 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent states that the petitioner's application has been forwarded on 12.03.2018 to the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent – Gram Panchayat. Sri G.Narendar Reddy, appearing for the respondents 3 and 4, states that the competent Gram Panchayat for sanction of the building permission is the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent Gram Panchayat and not the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent Gram Panchayat.

4. Since the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent has already granted technical approval to the petitioner's building permission application, the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent is directed to address the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent to consider sanctioning the building permission to the petitioner and communicate a copy of that proceeding to the

petitioner within three weeks from date of receipt of copy of the order. On receipt of such communication from the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent or the petitioner, the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent shall take appropriate action thereon within four weeks thereafter.

5. Accordingly and with the above directions, this writ petition is disposed of. Miscellaneous petitions pending consideration, if any, in this case shall stand closed as consequence. There shall be no order as to costs.
