Abhishek Reddy, Advocate for the Respondent No. 2 and Sri Deepak Bhattacharjee, Advocate for the respondent Nos. 3 to 5, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

“Though the respondents filed a counter affidavit, this Court had to consider the rival contentions in detail.

Pending further orders in the Writ Petition, the students of the petitioner-Institution shall be allowed to write the examinations subject to payment of the examination fee, but the results shall not be declared.
