

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE M.SEETHARAMA MURTI

CIVIL REVISION PETITION No.3752 of 2018

ORDER:

When this civil revision petition, filed by the petitioner/JDR, is taken up for hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner/JDR may be permitted to withdraw the revision petition reserving liberty to file an application for stay of the execution proceedings either in the Execution Petition, which is pending before the Executing Court or before the trial Court, before which the applications filed for setting aside the *ex parte* decree and for condonation of delay in seeking to set aside the *ex parte* decree are pending.

2. Permission, as sought for, is accorded.
3. Accordingly, the Civil Revision Petition is disposed of as withdrawn, reserving liberty, as sought for.

There shall be no order as to costs.

Pending miscellaneous petitions, if any, shall stand closed in the light of this final order. No order as to costs.
