WRIT PETITION No.27977 of 2007

ORDER:

1. This writ petition has been filed challenging the orders passed by the Industrial Tribunal, in I.D.No.119 of 2004 dated 5.2.2007, rejecting the case of the petitioner without granting any relief.
2. When the matter is taken up for hearing, it has been informed by the learned Counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has attained the age of superannuation.
3. This Court feels that the relief sought by the petitioner for in this writ petition cannot be granted at this length of time, as the petitioner has already attained the age of superannuation, and that this writ petition can be disposed of, directing the respondents to pay the service benefits to the petitioner, for the service rendered by him, if not already paid, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
4. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is disposed of, directing the respondents to pay the service benefits to the petitioner, for the service rendered by him, if not already paid, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. There shall be no order as to costs. Miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
