CIVIL REVISION PETITION No.3934 of 2018

ORDER:

This civil revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution arises out of the docket order dated 31.01.2018 passed by the learned Junior Civil Judge, Maheshwaram, Ranga Reddy District, in O.S.No.21 of 2016. By the said docket order, the trial Court held that copies of insufficiently stamped deeds were not admissible in evidence. These documents were sought to be introduced by defendants 1 and 2 in the suit, the petitioners herein.

While matters stood thus, it is now stated before this Court that an independent application has been filed under Section 65 of the Indian Evidence Act, 1872, to mark the very same documents as secondary evidence.

In the light of this later development, the cause in this civil revision petition does not survive for independent adjudication on merits.

The civil revision petition is accordingly dismissed. Pending miscellaneous petitions, if any, shall also stand dismissed. No order as to costs.
