

HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE ABHINAND KUMAR SHAVILI

WRIT PETITION No.14360 of 2010

ORDER :

The grievance of the petitioners is that they are working with the respondents on casual basis, but the respondents are not considering their cases for regularization. It has been contended by the petitioners that the persons who were appointed along with them, were all regularized, but when it came to them, respondents are deliberately not regularizing their services. Aggrieved of the same, the present writ petition is filed seeking directions to the respondents to regularize the services of petitioners.

Learned Standing Counsel for respondents has contended that the respondent-Unit had been closed in January, 2017, and as on today, it is not functioning, therefore, at this point of time, the respondents cannot consider the cases of petitioners for regularization of their services. There are no merits in the writ petition and the same is liable to be dismissed.

This Court, having considered the rival submissions of the parties, is of the considered view that admittedly as the petitioners are not in service as on today, this writ petition can be disposed of directing the petitioners to submit a representation to the respondents within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, seeking service benefits for the services rendered by them, or for employment in other Units of HMT, and upon such

representation being received, the respondents shall consider the same and pass appropriate orders within four weeks thereafter.

With the above observations, the writ petition is disposed of.

No order as to costs.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed.
