

HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE A.RAJASHEKER REDDY

WRIT PETITION No.26724 OF 2018

ORDER:

This writ petition is filed challenging the action of the respondents 4 and 6 in interfering with the civil disputes of the petitioner.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home produced written instructions stating that there is friction among the members of the petitioner church, one being lead by the petitioner and the other being lead by the 7th respondent; that in fact, both parties i.e. one G.S.Chitti Babu @ S.Pllaiah @ Devadanam, belonging to the petitioners group and the 7th respondent made a representation dated 20.07.2018 and 21.07.2018, respectively, requesting to provide Police Bandobast on 22.07.2018 to avoid any untoward incident in the church; and that in view of the above request of both groups, the Sub-Inspector of Police, Ananthapuram, III Town Police Station along with staff made necessary arrangements to see that no untoward incident occur on 22.07.2018 at the Church. It is also stated that the respondent police have never interfered with the civil disputes of the petitioner as alleged in the writ petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner obtained injunction against 8th respondent, inspite of the same police are interfering with the civil disputes of the petitioner.

In the written instructions it is clearly stated that police are not interfering with the civil disputes between petitioner and 8th respondent, except providing Police Bandobast.

Recording the same, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent police not to interfere with the civil disputes pending between the petitioner and 8th respondent. However, this order will not preclude the respondent police from maintaining law and order and investigating the crimes if any. No order as to costs.

As a sequel thereto, miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in the writ petition, shall stand closed.
