The Court made the following:

JUDGMENT: (*per Hon'ble Sri Justice C.V.Nagarjuna Reddy*)

This Criminal Appeal is filed by the *de facto* complainant against the acquittal of respondent No.1–the sole accused in Sessions Case No.410 of 2010 on the file of the IV Additional District and Sessions Judge, Nellore, *vide* judgment, dated 19.8.2011.

At the hearing, Mr. G.Vijaya Saradhi, learned counsel for the appellant, fairly conceded that the appellant has not sought and secured leave from this Court for filing this Criminal Appeal, which is held mandatory by the Apex Court in ***Satya Pal Singh Vs State of M.P. and Ors¹***.

In view of the incurable defect on account of the failure on the part of the appellant to obtain leave from this Court, the Criminal Appeal is liable to be dismissed on this ground alone.

The Criminal Appeal is accordingly dismissed.
