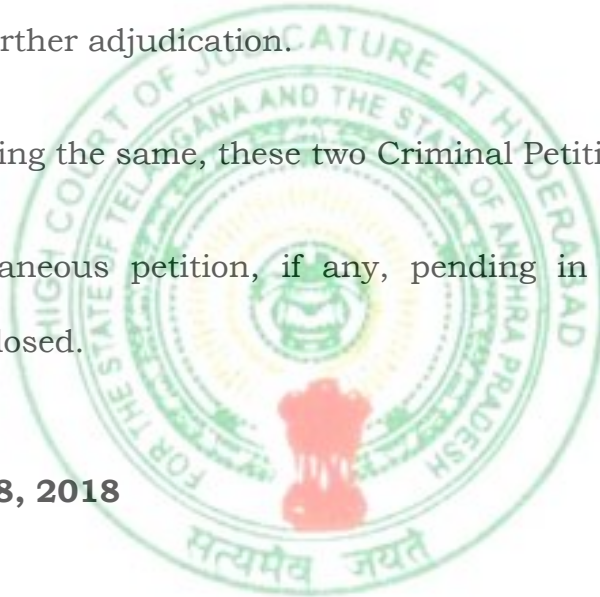
3. Recording the same, these two Criminal Petitions are closed.
