CRIMINAL PETITION No.8819 of 2018

ORDER :

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Public Prosecutor for the 1st respondent-State. For the 2nd respondent notice returned as unclaimed is sufficient service and taken as heard.

2. Perused the entire material on record. A perusal of the record shows there is nothing to interfere with the cognizance order of the learned Magistrate from the police final report for the offence under Section 509 IPC. At this stage, the learned counsel for the petitioner is seeking for direction to the trial Magistrate for early disposal of the case.
