COMMON ORDER:

No.111 of 2003, I.A. No.24 of 2010 in O.S. No.110 of 2003 and I.A. No.27 of 2010 in O.S. No.113 of 2003 respectively, on the file of V-Additional District Judge (Fast Track Court), Rangareddy District.

In fact, these Civil Revision Petitions are filed questioning the stay granted by the Court below in view of the Scheme sanctioned by B.I.F.R.
