WRIT PETITION No.32619 of 2018

ORDER:

The grievance of the petitioner is that respondent No.3 is not registering the F.I.R. against respondents 4 to 6 pursuant to her complaint, dated 29.08.2018.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home appearing for the respondent-police.

3. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the Writ Petition is disposed of directing the respondent-police to follow the guidelines laid down by Supreme Court in **LALITA KUMARI v GOVERNMENT OF UTTAR PRADESH¹**, and take appropriate action on the complaint stated to have been filed by the petitioner on 29.08.2018 in accordance with law.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this writ petition shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.
