

**THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE M.SEETHARAMA MURTI**

**WRIT PETITION No.32737 of 2018**

**ORDER:**

In this Writ Petition, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the only grievance of the writ petitioner is with regard to non-registration of a crime and non-issuance of an FIR pursuant to the report, dated 05.08.2017, of the petitioner lodged against the non-official respondents 5 to 10 with the Station House Officer, I Town Police Station, Eluru, West Godavari District.

**2.** I have heard the submissions of Sri *Penumaka Venkata Rao*, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner; and of the learned Government Pleader for Home (A.P.) appearing for the respondents 1 to 4. I have perused the material record.

**3.** Learned Government Pleader for Home, on instructions, submits that a case in Crime No.218 of 2018 was registered, on 10.09.2018, and that an FIR has been issued; and that in that view of the matter, the cause in the writ petition does not survive for adjudication and that, therefore, no further orders are necessary.

**4.** Recording the submission, the Writ Petition is disposed of as infructuous.

There shall be no order as to costs.

Consequently, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand dismissed.
