

**THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE M. SATYANARAYANA MURTHY**

**CRIMINAL PETITION No.9721 OF 2018**

**ORDER:**

This Criminal Petition, under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Code'), is filed by the petitioners - accused Nos.1 and 2, viz., Parameshwar Reddy and Sunil Shetty respectively, seeking to quash the proceedings against them in Crime/F.I.R.No.62 of 2018 dated 03.09.2018 on the file of Kodair (M) Police Station, Nagarkurnool, Telangana, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, and 7(A) of Essential Commodities Act, 1955.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners after arguing for sometime, requested this Court to direct the police to follow the procedure inlaid in Section 41-A of the Code and guidelines formulated by the Apex Court in **Arnesh Kumar v. State of Bihar**<sup>1</sup>.

3. Acceding to the request of the learned counsel for the petitioners and without touching the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to direct the police to follow the procedure inlaid in Section 41-A of the Code and the guidelines prescribed in **Arnesh Kumar**<sup>1</sup>. It is needless to mention that the Hon'ble Supreme Court made it clear that violation of guidelines prescribed in **Arnesh Kumar**<sup>1</sup> amounts to Contempt of Court action. Therefore, the Investigating

Agency is bound to adhere to the guidelines formulated by the Apex Court in **Arnesh Kumar**<sup>1</sup>.

4. With the above directions, the present Criminal Petition is disposed of at the stage of admission itself.

Consequently, Miscellaneous Petitions, if any, pending in the present Criminal Petition, stand closed.
