WRIT PETITION No. 33247 of 2018

ORDER:

- 1) Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and Government Pleader for Revenue. With the consent of both the parties, the writ petition is disposed of at the admission stage itself.
- 2) The present writ petition came to be filed seeking issuance of writ of mandamus declaring the action of respondent No.3 in not disposing the appeal pending vide Rc.E.727/2015, as illegal and arbitrary.
- 3) Though various grounds are raised in the writ petition, learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer seeking a direction to the respondent – authorities concerned to dispose of the appeal, at the earliest. Learned Government Pleader for Revenue does not oppose the same.
- 4) Recording the said submission, the Writ Petition is disposed of directing the respondent – authorities to dispose of the appeal vide Rc.E.727/2015, dated 19.05.2015, in accordance with law, as early as possible, preferably within a period of three (03) months from the date of receipt of a copy of the order.
- 5) Miscellaneous petitions, pending if any, shall stand closed in the light of this final order. No order as to costs.
