The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of T RAJINIKANTH REDDY, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of PUBLIC PROSECUTOR (TG), for the Respondent, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

CRIMINAL PETITION No.10496 of 2018

ORDER:

This petition is filed seeking for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, who is A2, in Crime No.259 of 2017 on the file of the Station House Officer, Ghatkesar Police Station, Rachakonda District. The offences alleged are under Sections 448, 384 and 506 IPC.

2. Heard the counsel for the petitioner and the Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent.

3. The allegations in the complaint are that the petitioner and A1 have entered into the room of the complainant without permission and threatened them saying that as to who they are to take single room and residing with a girl and demanded to give Rs.1,000/-.

4. The nature of the aforesaid allegations does not deserve ^{the} anticipatory bail to the petitioner. However, considering the submissions of the counsel for the petitioner that A1 was granted regular bail and that the marriage of this petitioner is scheduled to be held on 13.10.2018, this court opines that petitioner can be granted anticipatory bail.

5. With the above observations, this Criminal Petition is allowed. The petitioner/A2 is directed to surrender before the Station House Officer, Ghatkesar Police Station, Rachakonda District, within 15 days from the date of this order. On such

surrender, the petitioner shall be released on bail on his executing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the said Station House Officer. Further, on such release, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions mentioned under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C., as under:

- i) The petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required.
- ii) The petitioner shall appear before the aforesaid police station once in a week i.e., on every Sunday between 09:00 AM to 12:00 noon.
- iii) The petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- iv) The petitioner shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.

As a sequel, the miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall stand closed.
