COMMON ORDER:

I.A.Nos. 03 and 04 of 2018

These applications are filed seeking leave of this Court to compound the offences punishable under Sections 498-A IPC and Sections 3 and 4 of DP Act and to record compromise in C.C.No.23 of 2016 on the file of Special Mobile Magistrate, Guntur, on the ground that during pendency of this petition due to intervention of elders, the disputes between the parties have settled and they intend to lead peaceful life in future and it is voluntary.

De facto complaint and the accused are present in person and they are identified by their respective counsel and they also produced the copies of Aadhar Cards in proof of their identity.

On enquiry, the parties stated that they settled the dispute outside the Court due to intervention of elders and well wishers and the respondents agreed to pay Rs.24,00,000/- towards full and final settlement of the dispute. *De facto* complainant and Accused further stated that they decided to live separately to lead peaceful life in future and the compromise is voluntary and the dispute is purely personal and not against the societal interest.

Accordingly, these Applications are allowed permitting the parties to compound the said offences and to record compromise.

CrI.P.No.10617 of 2018

In view of the Orders passed in I.A.Nos. 03 and 04 of 2018, this Criminal Petition is allowed and the proceedings in C.C.No.23 of 2016 on the file of Special Mobile Magistrate, Guntur, are hereby quashed.

As a sequel, miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this case, shall stand dismissed.
