ORDER:

This writ petition is filed assailing the in-action on the part of the 3rd respondent in considering the revision petition as also the stay petition filed by the petitioners against the orders of the 4th respondent in appeal no.C/1066/2016, dated 19-07-2018 and for issuance of appropriate consequential directions, in the interest of justice.
