COMMON JUDGMENT: {Per the Hon'ble Sri Justice Ramesh Ranganathan}

Sri B.Narasimha Sarma, learned Senior Standing Counsel for Central Excise and Customs and Service Tax, submits that, since this appeal is below the monetary limit of Rs.50,00,000/-, the appellant does not wish to prosecute the appeal in the light of the Circular instructions issued by the Central Board of Indirect Taxes & Customs dated 11.07.2018. An application is also filed seeking withdrawal of the appeal.

Permission is accorded and the application is ordered. The appeal is, therefore, dismissed as withdrawn. There shall be no order as to costs. Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending shall stand dismissed.
