

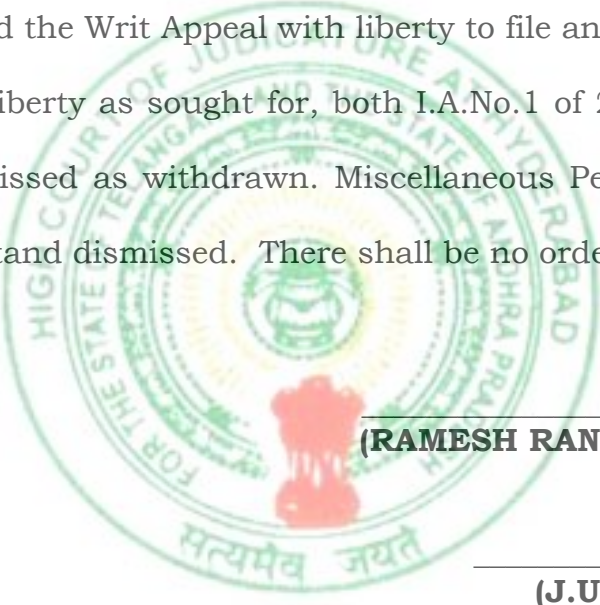
**THE HON'BLE THE ACTING CHIEF JUSTICE RAMESH RANGANATHAN

COMMON JUDGMENT: (Per the Hon'ble the Acting Chief Justice Ramesh Ranganathan)

It is stated by Sri K.V.Raghuveer, learned counsel for the applicants/appellants, that subsequent to the filing I.A.No.1 of 2017 seeking leave, the applicants/appellants have been impleaded as respondents in the Writ Petition and that an application to grant leave to prefer an appeal against the interim order in the said Writ Petition is no longer necessary.
