W.P.No.16120 OF 2002

ORDER

1. This writ petition is filed for the following relief:

“...to call for the records from the 3rd respondent and issue an appropriate writ, order or direction, particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring that the action of 3rd respondent in preventing the petitioners from discharge of their duties w.e.f 26.06.2002 without giving any order in writing and without disclosing any reasons as illegal, unjust, contrary to law, arbitrary, in violation of principles of natural justice, in violation of Sec.25-N and Sec.25-F of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947, amounts to an act of victimization, unfair labour practice and violative of Articles 14, 16 & 21 of the Constitution of India and grant all consequential benefits.”

2. When the matter is taken up for hearing, learned counsel on either side, submit in pursuance of the interim order granted by this Court on 27-08-2002 in WPMP No.20238 of 2002, the petitioners have been continued in service and subsequently, their services were regularized.

3. In view of the said submission, the Writ Petition is closed. No costs.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending shall stand closed.
