Challenging two possessions notices, one issued on 19-6-2018 and another issued on 29-10-2018, the borrower has come up with the above writ petition.

2. Heard Mr. T.Vijaya Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner. Smt. V.Dyumani, learned Standing Counsel, takes notice for the respondent/Bank.

3. As against the possession notices, the petitioner has an alternative remedy of appeal to the Debts Recovery Tribunal.
