CRIMINAL PETITION No.12957 OF 2018

ORDER:

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Public Prosecutor appearing for respondents 1 and 2 in opposing the criminal petition, before ordering notice to respondent No.3/ de facto complainant and perused the material on record.

On perusal of the material on record, there is nothing to admit and keep the matter pending for notice to respondent No.3 and hearing, but for, to say as none of the offences are punishable above seven years, police strictly follow Section 41-A Cr.P.C.

Having regard to the above, the Criminal Petition is disposed of, directing the police to proceed with the investigation and in the event of any necessity of arrest of the petitioner, they have to follow Section 41-A Cr.P.C. and the guidelines of the Apex Court as laid down in Arnesh Kumar v. State of Bihar¹, strictly.

Miscellaneous petitions pending if any, shall stand closed.
