

HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE A.V.SESHA SAI

W.P.No.45549 of 2018

ORDER:-

When the matter is taken up, the written instructions furnished by the Sub-Inspector of Police, Maheshwaram Police Station, dated 18.12.2018, are placed on record by the learned Government Pleader. The said instructions read as under:-

“It is submitted that one A.Ram Reddy who is the 4th respondent herein lodged complaint with the respondent Police g the petitioners stating that he and his brother are the owners of the property in Sy.No.254/EE to the extent of Ac.2.04 gts., and in Sy.No.252/EE to the extent of Ac.0.1 gts., in Manasanpally Cross Roads. Further, the petitioners colluded with revenue officials trying to trespass the said property. Hence, requested to take necessary action against them.

Basing on the complaint, a case in Cr.No.242 of 2018 registered for the offences under Sections 447, 427 I.P.C., on 24.11.2018 at Maheshwaram Police Station and investigating into. During the course of investigation, it reveals that the matter is pending before the ROR proceedings vide No.A2/3042/2013. The investigation is going on.

Hence, I deny all the allegations made by the petitioner are false and baseless. In view of the above mentioned facts, it is prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to dismiss the Writ Petition.”

Accordingly, the Writ Petition is disposed of, by placing on record the said instructions furnished by the Sub-Inspector of Police, Maheshwaram Police Station, dated 18.12.2018, with a further direction to the respondent-Police authorities not to

interfere with the civil disputes unless the same is permissible in accordance with law.

Miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
