ORDER:

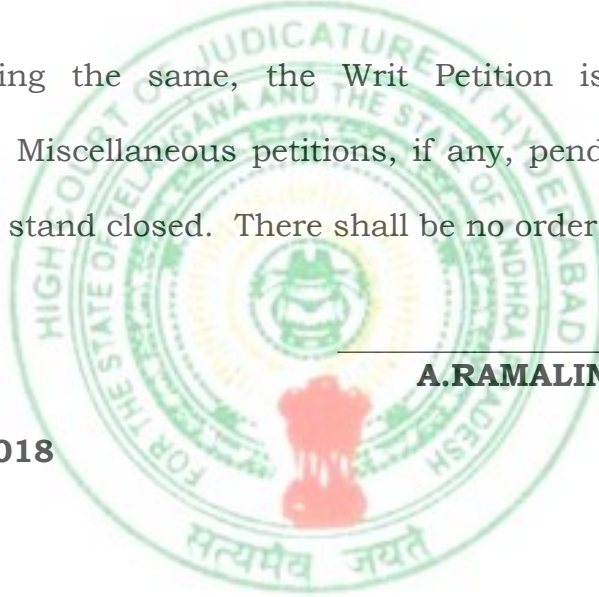
None appears for the petitioners.
