

**THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE M.S.RAMACHANDRA RAO**

**WRIT PETITION No.43892 of 2017**

**O R D E R:**

Petitioner contends that he preferred a Revision under Section 9 of the A.P. Rights in Land and Pattadar Passbook Act, 1971 before the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent, by sending the same by RPAD, against the endorsement dt.20.10.2016 of the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent and that the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent has not disposed of the said representation and had not even numbered it.

2. The Government Pleader for Revenue appearing for respondents 1 to 3 states that the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent will not only number the Revision but will also dispose it off within a period of three (03) months after giving notice to 4<sup>th</sup> respondent.

3. In view of the said submission, this Writ Petition is disposed of directing the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent to number the Revision and dispose of the same within a period of three (03) months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, after giving notice to the petitioner and 4<sup>th</sup> respondent, and communicate the same to the petitioner. No costs.

4. Consequently, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand dismissed.
