No. 250 of 2016 on the file of the Station House Officer, Anakapalli Town Police Station, Anakapalli, Visakhapatnam Rural, Visakhapatnam District, Andhra Pradesh.

The Court made the following ORDER:

This Criminal Petition, under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, is filed by the petitioner/accused No.2, for grant of **bail in** Crime No.250 of 2016 on the file of the Anakapalli Town Police Station, Visakhapatnam Rural, Visakhapatnam District, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 406 of I.P.C. and Section 5 of the A.P. Protection of Depositors of Financial Establishment Act.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner/accused No.2, learned Additional Public Prosecutor representing the respondent-State and perused the record.

3. In the course of submissions, it has come to light that the petitioner/accused No.2, along with her husband, ran private chits without required licence. The petitioner/accused No.2 was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 17.07.2017. It has also come to light that the petitioner/accused No.2 is indebted to the outsiders to a tune of about Rs.16,00,000/-. It is also brought to the notice of this Court that the husband of the petitioner/accused No.2 passed away. Having regard to the nature of allegations levelled

against the petitioner/accused No.2 and the material collected so far and as most of the material witnesses are examined, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner/accused No.2 under Section 439 of Cr.P.C.

4. Accordingly, the petitioner/accused No.2 is ordered to be released on bail on her executing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties in a like sum each to the satisfaction of the learned V Metropolitan Magistrate, Anakapalli, Visakhapatnam District. On such release, the petitioner/accused No.2 shall report before the Station House Officer, Anakapalli Town Police Station, Visakhapatnam Rural, Visakhapatnam District, on every Sunday between 08:00 AM and 09:00 AM, till filing of the charge-sheet.

5. The Criminal Petition is, accordingly, allowed.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this Criminal Petition, shall stand closed.
