S. J. VAZIFDAR, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral) :

Arbitration petition No. 255 of 2017 is for the appointment of an arbitrator under section 11 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. In the writ petition, the petitioner has claimed various reliefs based on the agreement which contains the arbitration clause. The arbitration agreement, however, exists

only between the petitioner and respondent No.1 to the writ petition who is also the respondent in the arbitration petition. The other respondents in the writ petition are not impleaded in the arbitration petition and this order, therefore, does not operate against them

2. The parties to the arbitration petition, who are the petitioner and respondent No.1 to the writ petition, agree that all the disputes and differences between them including those raised in the writ petition be referred to the sole arbitration of Ms. Justice Sneh Prashar, a former Judge of this Court. The fee shall be as per the Chandigarh Arbitration Centre (CAC) (Administrative Cost and Arbitrators' Fees) Rules, 2014.

3. The petitions are accordingly disposed of.
