This appeal has been preferred by Rashpal Singh for challenging the order dated 03.04.2018 passed by the learned Single Judge in COCP 851 of 2018, whereby the petition filed by him for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for willfully, deliberately and intentionally disobeying and flouting the order dated 09.11.2017 passed on the petition filed by him under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

The directions issued on 09.11.2017 in Criminal Misc.M-42569 of 2017 have already been complied with as the police has initiated inquest proceedings in respect of unnatural death of Ranjit Singh followed by post-mortem. In the post-mortem, no other injury, much less on the lips and face, indicates any forcible administration of the poison, as alleged by the appellant. As such, it cannot be said that no appropriate action has been taken on the statement dated

09.7.2017 of the appellant or representation dated 23.10.2017 submitted by him.

The appeal is devoid of any merit and, therefore, dismissed.
