JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The writ petition bearing *CWP No. 8481 of 2014* filed by the petitioner-Hem Pal Singh for allotment of a tenement under the Chandigarh Small Flat Scheme, 2006, being alleged displaced *jhuggi* dwellers of Colony No. 5, Burail, was disposed of alongwith the other connected matters vide order dated 22.12.2014 (**Annexure P-1**), passed by a Division Bench of this Court.

The petitioner filed the present contempt with the allegations that the orders dated 22.12.2014 (**P-1**) passed in the aforesaid writ petition have not been complied with.

Upon notice, a reply has been filed, stating that the petitioner had not produced any documentary proof/record to show his eligibility for allotment before the Estate Officer, U.T., Chandigarh and consequent

allotment of tenement before the Screening Committee/Estate Officer, U.T.,

Chandigarh.

At the time of hearing, counsel for respondent No. 1-U.T., Chandigarh, has produced/submitted an order dated 10.01.2018 of the office of Estate Office, Chandigarh, whereby the claim of the aforesaid allotment has been rejected. The same is taken on record. A copy of the same has been handed over to the counsel for petitioner.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted in the present contempt petition.

Disposed of.

The petitioner is free to challenge the aforesaid order dated 10.01.2018.
