The prayer is for counting of the previous service towards qualifying service for pension of the petitioner as Associate Professor (English) in a College, operated by the Municipal Council, Naya Nangal, before its taking over by the Government, was ordered to be decided within a period of two months vide order dated 01.08.2013 (**Annexure P-1**), passed in *CWP No.16509 of 2013*.

At the time of hearing, learned State counsel has filed an

affidavit dated 16.02.2018 of Shri Gurdarshan Singh Brar, Joint Director (Administration), O/o Director Public Instructions (Colleges), Punjab/ Respondent No.3, wherein in para No.3, it is stated as under:-

“ That in compliance of the above direction of the Hon'ble High Court the claim of the petitioner was considered and speaking order has been passed vide No.10/7-2017-S(5) dated 08.02.2018, whereby the claim of the petitioner has been allowed by granting with benefits of service rendered in the college under Municipal Committee, for pensionary benefits. A copy of order dated 08.02.2018 is appended herewith as Annexure R-1. ”

In view of the above, it is agreed that no further action in the present contempt petition is warranted as the same has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
