The petitioner has filed the present contempt, alleging that the order dated 20.01.2017 (**Annexure P-1**) passed by this Court in *CWP No.26145 of 2016* with regard to the claim for counting of previous service towards pensionary benefits upon the retirement of the petitioner w.e.f. 31.10.2007 has not been granted.

At the time of hearing, an affidavit dated 26.06.2018 of Shri Jagdeep Singh Galvatti, General Manager, Punjab Roadways, Rupnagar, has been filed. In the reply, it has been stated that the qualifying service for pensionary benefits has since been counted and the revised pension and amounts of gratuity in the process of being paid.

In view of the stand of respondents, no further action is warranted in the present contempt.
