JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The 14 residents including Ex. Sarpanch of Village Balongi Colony, Tehsil and District Mohali, have filed the present contempt alleging that the interim order dated 19.12.2014 (**Annexure P-1**) passed by a Division Bench of this Court in *CWP No. 26073 of 2014*, whereby the Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector, Mohali, was directed to ensure that Tarlochan Singh Mann should not discharge the functions of 'Numberdar' of the Village, has been violated, as he was permitted to function as the Numberdar.

At the time of hearing, it is conceded that the said interim order dated 19.12.2014 (**P-1**) was still on 15.01.2015, even otherwise the said aforesaid writ petition now stands dismissed and the appointment of Tarlochan Singh Mann as 'Numberdar' stands upheld.

In view of the above, counsel for the parties state that no further action is warranted in the present contempt petition and the same is liable to be dismissed.

Dismissed.
