Petitioner has approached this Court asserting violation of the order dated 23.05.2014 passed by this Court.

Perusal of the petition would show that there is no mention by the petitioner that the copy of the order passed by this Court had been supplied to the respondent or his office. Even the docket which has been sent through this Court, as has been asserted, has been denied to have been received in the office of the respondent. Specific affidavit to this effect has been filed by the respondent that the docket as sent by the High Court has not been received in the office of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga.

In view of the above, it cannot be said that the order dated 23.05.2014 passed by this Court was ever conveyed to the respondent or that he was aware of the same.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is not made out. The same, therefore, stands dismissed.
