JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner (Hanuman Singh) is the owner of the house constructed over the area measuring 30'x60' being 5/711 share of total area measuring 43 Kanals 04 Marlas comprised in Khewat No. 18 Khatuni No. 36 Sq. No. 18 Killa No. 23, situated at Village Khairpur, within the Municipal Limits of Sirsa, as per jamabandi for the year 2007-08 and the said property was acquired vide Award dated 12.01.2011.

It is averred that initially the petitioner filed a writ petition bearing *CWP No. 10832 of 2013* before this Court, seeking release of the land in the light of decision dated 31.10.2013 passed by a Division Bench in case *Lakhan Pal etc. Versus State of Haryana*. It is further averred that in the intervening period, there was some remand from Hon'ble the Supreme Court and accordingly, the petitioner filed separate writ petition bearing *CWP No. 5636 of 2014* seeking relief of de-notification/release of property alongwith construction of the petitioner.

The said writ petition bearing *CWP No. 5636 of 2014* was disposed of vide order dated 02.03.2017 (**Annexure P-1**) by a Division Bench of this Court, while deciding bunch of petitions in *CWP No. 16857 of 2010*, titled as '*The Sirsa Adarsh Cooperative House Building Society Limited and another Versus State of Haryana and others*', with a direction to the authorities to decide the representations to be filed by the petitioner(s) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of such representation after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner(s).

The petitioner, thereafter, submitted representation dated 27.03.2017 (**Annexure P-2**) before the Director General, Urban Estates Department, Haryana, Chandigarh, but no action has been taken so far, hence the present contempt petition.

At the time of hearing, counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
