Petitioner is a Daily Wager engaged by the Punjab School Education Board, Mohali for undertaking work as and when required. She had claimed the relief that the respondents be directed not to permit any break in her service period as in case of other daily wagers, they were permitting to be employed continuously. CWP No.25906 of 2017 filed by the petitioner claiming such a relief was disposed of with order dated 14.11.2017 passed by this Court, whereby the respondents were directed to consider his claim by passing a speaking order.

A speaking order dated 01.03.2018 concededly stands passed. However, the petitioner claims that the respondents have committed contempt since it does not consider the spirit of the relief claimed.

After arguing for sometime, learned Counsel for the petitioner

prays for permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
