Learned counsel for the respondent has produced a communication dated 12.11.2018 received from the Director, Secondary Education, Haryana, according to which full pay and salary for the period from 10.11.1983 to 13.11.1984 amounting to ₹12,589/- has been credited to the account of Devki Rani wife of Dalip Singh-deceased employee.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as such.

Counsel for the petitioners states that the other consequential benefits were to be released to the petitioners.

Perusal of the order passed by this Court in CWP No.6789 of 1995 would show that the only issue, which was adjudicated upon and decided by the Court, was limited to the extent of regularisation of the period of suspension of the petitioner for treating it as duty period, for which a direction was issued to the respondents and in

compliance thereof, speaking order dated 23.07.2018 (Annexure R-1) has been passed by the Director, Secondary Education, Haryana, treating the suspension period as duty period and has, therefore, granted the benefit of remaining salary. In any case, the petitioners, if have any other grievance apart from the one which has already been adjudicated upon, they may avail of their remedy in accordance with law, if permissible.

Rule issued to the respondent stands discharged.
