Mr. Rajesh K. Sheoran, Additional Advocate General, Haryana has handed over a copy of the order dated 17.10.2018 passed by the Department of Women and Child Development promoting the petitioner as Assistant to the post of Superintendent (Gazetted) w.e.f. 18.12.2007 from the date on which his immediate junior Chand Ram was promoted to the post of Superintendent and was also entitled to actual pay w.e.f. the actual date of joining to the post of Superintendent. Learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana further stated that the consequential benefits have been awarded. The arrears of salary after re-fixation have also been deposited in the account of the petitioner.

In view of the order dated 17.10.2018 as well as in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State in Court, this Court does not deem it fit to proceed with the contempt petition, the same is

accordingly dismissed.

However, in case the petitioner is not satisfied with said order passed, he is at liberty to avail of legal remedy available to him in accordance with law.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
