The petitioners are the plaintiff/decreed-holders of a declaration of ownership to the extent of their claimed share alongwith joint possession.

By filing the present contempt petition, it is alleged that the revenue officials are not effecting the necessary mutations based on the decree inspite of the two years having lapsed since the time of making the proper application under the provisions of the Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1887.

After arguing for sometime, counsel for the petitioners realizes that proper remedy to seek the directions would be a writ jurisdiction for mandamus the revenue authorities to decide such application in time bound manner.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal the present contempt petition to enable his client to avail remedy in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty, as prayed for.
