Landlord has filed the present contempt with the averments that the directions to pay monthly rent by the 7th of each calendar month as also clear all arrears of rent as directed vide order dated 17.01.2017 in the pending revision filed by the tenant have not been complied with and, therefore, committed Contempt of Court.

After hearing learned Counsel for the petitioner no ground to invoke the contempt jurisdiction is made out.

The aforesaid directions are the conditions imposed for seeking the benefit of stay of dispossession from the demised premises by the tenant and violation of the same would entitle the landlord to seek execution of the eviction decree.

In view of the above, finding no merit in the present contempt

petition, the same is hereby dismissed.
