The petitioner had filed CWP No.20827 of 2015 seeking direction to the Executive Engineer (respondent No.4 therein) to pass an appropriate order on his letter dated 22.06.2015. The said petition was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 30.09.2015 (**Annexure P-1**) with a direction to the respondent to consider the aforesaid letter and pass an appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of that order. Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, reply by way of affidavit of the respondent has been filed, wherein it is submitted that the claim of the petitioner has been considered and the due payment has since been made to the petitioner vide Cheque No.371173 dated 12.10.2016 (**Annexure R-2**).

Learned Counsel for the respondent submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the aforesaid directions stand complied with.

In response, learned Counsel for the petitioner concedes the aforesaid factual position.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.
