AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court asserting non-compliance of the order dated 18.01.2016 passed by this Court in the writ petition preferred by him, whereby, directions were issued to the respondent to consider and decide the legal notice dated 09.11.2015.

In compliance with the said order, respondent has filed the reply, according to which, the claim of the petitioner has been considered and decided vide order dated 09.08.2017 (Annexure R-3) and as per the same, 20% share of NPS amounting to ₹ 32,003/- was deposited in the bank account of the petitioner on 12.05.2017. The remaining amount has to be paid by the agency dealing with NPS i.e. NSDL, Mumbai.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed as having been rendered infructuous. Let the petitioner approach the NPS Agency i.e. NSDL, Mumbai, for disbursal of the remaining amount.

Rule issued to the respondent stands discharged.
