Affidavit dated 26.10.2018 of the Director, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training, Punjab, has been filed in Court, according to which all the pensionary benefits have been released to the petitioner along with interest. This renders the present contempt petition infructuous.

Counsel for the petitioner, however, states that the husband of the petitioner was also entitled to the ACP scheme, which benefit has not been released.

Let the petitioner put forth such a claim before the respondents, which will be considered and decided expeditiously preferably within a period of eight weeks from the date of submission of such claim.

The present contempt petition is disposed of accordingly.
