Petitioner had approached this Court alleging non-compliance of the order dated 06.02.2017 passed by this Court in CRM-M No.337 of 2017, whereby directions were issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, S.A.S. Nagar, District Mohali, to decide the complaints/representations dated 03.04.2016 and 15.09.2016 moved by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order.

2. Counsel for the respondent, on the basis of the reply which has been filed in Court, submits that the representation of the petitioner has been duly considered and a speaking order dated 24.02.2017 has been passed, copy whereof has been appended as Annexure R-2/T. Counsel further states that in pursuance to the decision taken by the Senior Superintendent of Police, S.A.S. Nagar, District Mohali, two FIRs have been registered, one is FIR No.14 dated 14.01.2016 (Annexure R-4/T) under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC, Police Station Zirakpur and the other is FIR No.76 dated 24.02.2017 under Sections 406/420 IPC, Police Station Zirakpur. He further states that Rupinder Singh Gill, Narinder Singh Gill and Sandeep Kaur have been declared proclaimed offenders by the

concerned Illaqa Magistrate.

3. In view of the above, the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous.
4. Disposed of as such.
5. Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
