The petitioner had filed a writ petition bearing *CWP No.21806 of 2015, inter alia*, directing the respondents to decide his application dated 09.06.2015 regarding entering mutation in favour of him and other co-owners on the basis of judgment and decree dated 06.02.2014 passed by learned Additional District Judge, Mohali, whereby the appeal preferred by the defendants against the suit for declaration, which was decreed in favour of petitioner for possession of stated land, was dismissed. The aforesaid writ petition was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 12.10.2015 **(Annexure P-1)**, with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Collector by

making an application and the same shall be decided within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

Since no action was taken on the application of the petitioner within stipulated time of four months, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, reply stands filed, wherein in *para No.6*, it is stated that the action on the application filed by the petitioner dated 24.02.2016 has already been taken by the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Kharar, which has also been intimated to the petitioner.

In view of above, counsel for the parties concede that the order in question has been complied with, no further action is warranted in the present contempt petition.

Disposed of.

Rule is discharged.
