In the light of the affidavit dated 07.03.2018 filed by Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana, according to which, encroachments on the chhappar have been removed and the possession thereof has been handed over to the Gram Panchayat, Daheru. The Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Khanna, has also issued a letter dated 29.12.2017 (Annexure A-6) to the Sarpanch, Gram Panchayat, Daheru, directing him to maintain the status over the chhappar and to initiate proceedings under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961, if any suspicion arises regarding illegal occupation over the chhappar or any other encroachment, which comes to its knowledge.

In the light of the said compliance report, the present contempt petition is disposed of.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
