RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (Oral)

The U.T. Administration after notice to the occupiers of unauthorized or illegal constructions have taken effective steps to demolish those illegal constructions in Khuda Alisher within the territorial jurisdiction of the U.T. Administration. The illegal liquor vends operating in the periphery of Chandigarh have had their licences suspended by the Administration. That takes care of the implementation of the order dated 21.12.2017 passed by the Division Bench of this Court.

Compliance report has been filed by the Deputy Commissioner, Chandigarh and the same is retained on record.

The U.T. Administration assures that they will take continuous steps to ensure that no illegal constructions are raised or commercial activities carried out in the areas concerned. The liquor vends have been asked to relocate to proper premises elsewhere.

With this, the order has been implemented which renders the petition infructuous.

Rule is discharged.

The petition is dismissed as infructuous.
