This Court at the instance of the petitioner in CRM-M-46022 of 2016 had directed the Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Amritsar, to look into the complaint made by the petitioner in respect of the allegations of cheating against Rajinder Singh Patwari and his wife Sukhwinder Kaur, vide order dated 23.12.2016 (**Annexure P-1**).

Since, allegedly nothing substantial has been done, hence, the present contempt.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from *HC Harmanjit Singh, Belt No.483, Police Station Ajnala, Punjab*, states that on concluding an enquiry, an *FIR No.110 dated 06.07.2018*, stands registered against

Rajinder Singh Patwari and his wife Sukhwinder Kaur, hence the order in question has been complied with, therefore, no further action is warranted in the present contempt petition.
